



BaseWest's Model 601, P/N 6-1020 battery pack is FAA/PMA approved for use with the Astronics/DME Model EF-1 Series airline emergency flashlight and is a direct replacement for the original equipment battery pack.

Unlike some battery packs that are approved for the same application, the BaseWest battery uses only the highest quality Energizer® alkaline "AA" cells.

Design features include resistance-welded intercell contacts, Teflon®-insulated wire and a case molded of flame-retardant ABS.

Batteries are shipped with protective cap plugs over the connectors to prevent inadvertent discharge or short circuit.
